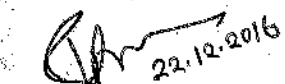
They also shed light on the various microbiological instruments and pathological tests, experiments, medical microbiology.

- Each student will prepare an individual project report applying the project methodology.
- A group of maximum five students may work on same topic under the guidance of a teacher.
- The actual work of the project should be carried out throughout the year. Topic must be select after the admission to the course.
- Project report should be checked & certified by guiding teacher before final submission.
- Student should submit two hard copy (bind) and softcopy (CD) of Project report to department of geography before one month of commencement of university examinations.
- The project report will have preliminary pages such as Cover Page, Declaration by Candidate, Certificate by Guide, Acknowledgement, Contents, List of tables, maps, graphs, diagrams, photos etc.

The students of Geography visited Daulatabad fort and Elora on 29/02/2020 in order to study the geographical location of the ancient caves and Deogiri fort. Daulatabad is historical fortified citadel located in Deogiri village near Aurangabad in Maharashtra state. It was the capital of the Yadava dynasty (9th century–14th century CE), for a brief time the capital of the Delhi Sultanate (1327–1334), and later a secondary capital of the Ahmadnagar Sultanate (1499–1636).

The outer wall, 2.75 miles (4.43 km) in circumference, once enclosed the ancient city of Devagiri and between this and the base of the upper fort are three lines of defenses. Along with the fortifications, Daulatabad contains several notable monuments, of which the chief are the Chand Minar and the Chini Mahal. The Chand Minar is a tower 210 ft (64 m). high and 70 ft (21 m). in circumference at the base, and was originally covered with beautiful Persian glazed tiles.

The students also visited Ellora caves and studied the rocks. There are over 100 caves at the site, all excavated from the basalt cliffs in the Charanandri Hills, 34 of which are open to public. These consist of 17 Hindu (caves 13–29), 12 Buddhist (caves 1–12) and 5 Jain (caves 30–34) caves, each group representing deities and mythologies prevalent in the 1st millennium CE, as well as monasteries of each respective religion. They were built close to one another and illustrate the religious harmony that existed in ancient India. All of the Ellora monuments were built during the Rashtrakuta dynasty, which constructed part of the Hindu and Buddhist caves, and the Yadava dynasty, which constructed a number of the Jain caves. Funding for the construction of the monuments was provided by royals, traders and the wealthy of the region.

Total 60 students of B.A. III and 18 students of M.A. took an active part in the study tour. The tour proved to be immensely beneficial for students and they learned a lot of the historical city which rich from geographical perspectives. The students prepared reports of the study.

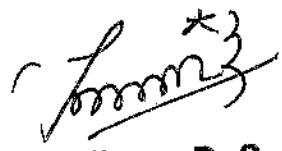

This dam is created in 1930. It is 8 km away at north of Jalna city. The first pipeline to supply water to Jalna city was arranged in the year 1935. It supplied 50,000 liters' water to the people of Jalna in the older times. The special feature of this dam is that it supplies water without the aid of any electrical equipment. The water runs through the pipes with the help of gravitational force. This dam is surrounded by hills. The length of this dam is 836 meters and height is 50 meters. Total water storage capacity of this dam is 3464 cubic meters.

Total 38 students of B.A. III and 26 students of M.A. took an active part in the study tour. The tour proved to be immensely beneficial for students and they learned a lot of the historical city which rich from geographical perspectives. The students prepared reports of the study.

In practical there should not be more than 20 students in a batch. In theory, there should not be more than 100 students in a batch.

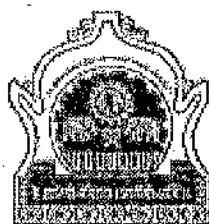

Teaching Methodologies

The Core Module Syllabus for Environmental Studies includes class room teaching and Field Work. The syllabus is divided into eight units covering 100 lectures. The first seven units will cover 70 lectures which are class room based to enhance knowledge skills and attitude to environment. Unit eight is based on field activities which will be covered in 30 lecture hours and would provide students first hand knowledge on various local environmental aspects. Field experience is one of the most effective learning tools for environmental concerns. This moves out of the scope of the text book mode of teaching into the realm of real learning in the field, where the teacher merely acts as a catalyst to interpret what the student observes or discovers in his/her own environment. Field studies are as essential as class work and form an irreplaceable synergistic tool in the entire learning process.

Course material provided by UGC for class room teaching and field activities be utilized.

The universities/colleges can also draw upon expertise of outside resource persons for teaching purposes.
